

Supporting Information for Agricultural Water Use Applications

FISHERIES AND OCEANS - CANADA

Applicants considering withdrawals from, or the conduct of works or undertakings around or in water which could be utilised by fish are advised to contact the Habitat and Enhancement Branch of Fisheries and Oceans Canada (DFO) at 393-6721 or 393-6722 early in their planning process. DFO will be able to indicate the sensitivity of the waters and, in most cases, advise applicants of mitigation which will ensure that the provisions of the *Fisheries Act* are not contravened by their operation. This mitigation could include the screening of pump intakes, the design and construction of stream crossings, the control of sediment etc.

Pesticide Use Information

Applicants using pesticides should contact the Standards and Approvals Section, Department of Environment, Government of Yukon at 667-5610 for further information.

Pesticide Use Permits are **NOT** required if pesticides will be used for agricultural production on land that the individual owns or leases, except for:

- a) Using pesticides within thirty metres of an open body of water;
- b) Using restricted pesticides (see attached list);
- c) Application of pesticide from an aircraft;
- d) Possessing or using particularly toxic pesticides as identified in Schedule 4 of the pesticide regulations.

If a farmer hires a person or business to apply pesticides that person or business must have a Pesticide Applicator Certificate and Pesticide Service Permit.

FEES

The application should be accompanied by a \$30.00 application fee as well as a first year water use fee. To calculate the water use fee, please see section 8 of the *Waters Regulation* or call the Water Board at (867) 456-3980 for assistance.
