



COMPOSITION OF THE BOARD

As per the [Waters Act](#) and [Umbrella Final Agreement](#), membership is from 4 to 9 people, appointed by the Minister of Executive Council for a three-year term. At least three persons are nominated by the Government Leader, one-third of the members are nominated by the Council of Yukon First Nations, and the remaining members are nominated by the federal government departments that are most directly concerned with the management of waters. Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson are appointed from within the Board membership. The appointment is made by the Premier, in consultation with the Board. Board members are not delegates of the parties who nominate them.

An appointment replacing a member whose term has not expired can only be for the unexpired portion of that term.
