The following bulletin contains information pertaining to Placer Undertaking applications as outlined in the Umbrella Final Agreement.

Water Licence Terms for Placer Applications...

Please note: Section 14.7.2 of the Umbrella Final Agreement (UFA) states that "Where the Board licenses a Water Use to a Person referred to in 14.7.1, the term of that licence shall not extend beyond the term of the right or interest in Settlement Land." For placer mining grants on Settlement Land, including category A and B land, the term of the right or interest ends on the expiry date of the grant as stated on the claim status report issued by the Mining Recorder. The expiry date of a water licence issued by the Board cannot go beyond the expiry date of the grant(s), if any portion of any of the grants included in the water licence application are on Settlement Land. This applies to active claims that existed before the UFA, and to new claims staked on Category B Settlement Land. This does not apply to a right or interest in Settlement Land granted by a Yukon First Nation.
