REASONS FOR DECISION  
ASSIGNMENT OF WATER USE LICENCE AG91-001

The Yukon Territory Water Board ("the Board") has approved the assignment of water use licence AG91-001, a type B licence for agricultural purposes, from Jerry Reid to Steve MacKenzie-Grieve.

Water Use Licence AG91-001 was issued September 11, 1991. An Environmental Assessment Review Process ("EARP") screening and decision report was prepared at that time. The determination of that EARP screening and decision report was that any potentially adverse environmental and related socio-economic effects that may be caused by the project are insignificant or mitigable with known technology. The assignment does not constitute any change to the project, except a change to the name of the proponent.

Declaration of Licensee  
Declaration of Assignee  
Contract of Purchase and Sale

The declaration of the assignee confirms that the assignee accepts all legal rights and obligations confirmed by the water use licence, including any obligations of the assignor.

The Yukon Waters Act and Regulations require that the Board shall authorize the assignment of a licence if the Board is satisfied that the sale or other disposition of the property and the operation of the project by the assignee will not be likely to result in a contravention of either the licence or the Yukon Waters Act.

The Board is satisfied that the requirements of the Act have been met and the assignment of this licence is therefore approved.
