



APPLICATION FOR ASSIGNMENT  
WATER USE LICENCE AG93-001  
REASONS FOR DECISION

This is an application to assign water use licence AG93-001, a B licence for an agricultural undertaking from Barbara Drury to Warren Zakus.

The Licence was issued November 5, 1993. An Environmental Assessment was completed in accordance with the requirements of the *EARP*. The assignment does not constitute any change to the project, except a change to the name of the proponent.

The declaration of the assignee confirms that the assignee accepts all legal rights and obligations confirmed by the water use licence, including any obligations of the assignor.

The Department of Environment (Environmental Affairs, Water Inspections and Agricultural branches) and Department of Fisheries & Oceans were notified of the application, and did not respond. No comments were received on this application.

The *Waters Act (Act)* and *Waters Regulation* require that the Board shall authorize the assignment of a licence if the Board is satisfied that the sale or other disposition of the property and the operation of the project by the assignee will not be likely to result in a contravention of either the licence or the *Act*.
