Ralph Troberg's PM08 - 616 amendment to application PM00 - 17

Dear Joelle,

Thank you for your letter of February 16, 2009. The enclosed responses are in addition to my letter of February 12, 2009. The same number system will be used in this correspondence as used in your February 16 requests.

1. The three options that you have outlined for proceeding with the submission of Mr. Troberg's PM08 - 616 due have their pros and cons. At this time Option #1 - Process as an Amendment, appears to resolve the issues that Mr. Troberg wants to accomplish. That is: a) to have a Water Use license and Mining Land Use Operating Plan for 10 years from the date of issuance of this amendment and b) to include the changes to the original Water Use License and Mining Land Use Operating Permit as requested in the amendment submission. To complete this approach, an Assignment of the License from Mr. Troberg to Mr. Troberg's company Early Day Adventures, has been completed and is enclosed with a copy of this letter.
2. PM08 - 616 will be considered independently of PM00 - 173.
3. PM00 - 173 is in the name of Mr. Ralph Troberg. The amendment PM08 - 616 includes a request for a name change to Mr. Troberg's company name of Early Day Adventures Ltd. To do this name change will require an Assignment of the License and to this end the forms to Assign a License have been included with this correspondence. An updated Schedule IV has also been included to reflect this change.
4. It is understood that the Assignment and the Amendment cannot be processed simultaneously. It is requested that the Amendment be processed initially, followed by the Assignment.
5. A new page #16 is included with a copy of this letter. On that page, the daily flow rates have replaced the per second flow rates that were included on the page in the original version. The volumes of water needed for start up and daily make up are now available.
6. A corrected page 18 of the original application has been included with a copy of this letter. On this page are the amounts of

water for sluicing on the left limit and the right limit of Bonanza Creek and for the hydraulicing programs that are expected to be used during the proposed mining program. Please substitute this page for the original.

7. Page 49 of the original Water License application has been re-written to clarify your inquiries about the mechanisms of drainage for the settling ponds on the right limit, 1st tier left limit and the high elevation left limit bench.

8. An updated page #53 is included with a copy of this letter. The Boulder Creek channel has been added in the lower left of that mine site page. It can be seen that it does not play a role in the proposed mining plan. On page 15 of the original Water License application is the placer map with Boulder Creek entering from the lower left. In the last issued Water License Boulder Creek was named as a water source and as receiving water for treated mine effluent. In past few years it became apparent that Boulder Creek flow was much too minimal and unreliable to be used as a water source or a disposition source for mine effluent, hence the removal from the Water License via this amendment.

9. Enclosed please find the correct version of page #90. Please insure that this page replaces both the copies of page #90 in the amendment and that they get removed and discarded.
