Energy, Mines and Resources, Client Services & Inspections branch does not wish to call for a public hearing with regard to this application for a Type B Water License and a Class IV Placer Mining Land Use Approval.

We have the following information to contribute to the review of this application.

The proposed activity is in the Dawson Mining District and can be found on N.T.S. Map 1150-14 and latitude 63° 58' 89.0", longitude 139° 20' 44.7". The activity takes place along Bonanza Creek, a tributary of the Klondike River. Bonanza Creek is situated in the Klondike River Watershed Authorization with a moderate / moderate habitat suitability and an extensive development designation.

### COMMENTS OR CONCERNS

Pursuant to the Klondike River Watershed Authorization for Bonanza Creek the design target is 0.2 ml/L, action level is 1.0 ml/L and the compliance level is 2.5 ml/L. All authorized sediment discharge levels are measured in excess of natural background taken at a point above the uppermost mine operation. The point of compliance will be measured at a point in the effluent flow immediately before it enters the natural stream flow.
