Thank you for your letter and review of our application. Following will be the information and/or clarification you require.


1. a, Waste deposit location
 1. Source Motors in Haines, Junction – oils & solvents
 2. Landfill in Haines Junction for batteries etc. at designated area
- b. The only water extracted from Kimberley Creek is used in the trommel, the 320 m3/day. The existing fords used by us and the miners above, are marked on the map showing the camp access road and claims. If I forgot to include it, I'm enclosing another copy.
7. Leave the license in my name as in previous licenses.
8. New claim sheet just arrived and is enclosed.

Realizing the new license will not start until current one expires on September 30, 2010, we want to get an early start to be sure this is approved by that time.

The YWB confirmation form is enclosed. Any questions please contact Daniel Beaudin at the Haines Junction YESAA office. It was his impression that we did not need a new one since there were no changes in the operation.
