**Re: Water Use Licence and Mining Land Use Approval Application PM09-651,
Jarvis Creek, a tributary of Minto Creek**

I have completed a review of the above mentioned application received on October 14, 2009. In order to continue the review of your application I require that you provide the following information and/or clarification.

1. On page 5 of 45, Question 6 you have stated that you are the registered owner of all the grants, however there are other identified claim owners for the proposed mining operation. Patsy Jardine is the registered owner of P 42929, Earl Jardine is the registered owner of claims P 42755, P 42538, P 42927, P 42904 and P 42756, Lorelei Jardine is the registered owner of P 42955 and Mike Dettling is the registered owner of P 42954. In order to continue processing this application for all the claims listed, the Water Board requires that the above people submit a letter stating that you have their permission to mine the above claims.
2. Upon review of your application it was noticed that you stated that this area is within the Mayo River Watershed on Page 5 of 45, Question 3 and is zoned Freshwater Fisheries Production Zone. However, the new Fish Habitat Classification has not been finalized at this time. Therefore, you are under the Yukon Placer Authorization regime for the Mayo Basin and the stream classification is a Type IV B stream. Please update page 5 of 45, enclosed, and resubmit.
3. Page 27 of 45 of the information sheets is the Environmental Health Form. Upon review we have noticed that you have not signed this document. Please sign and date the copy enclosed and return it to this office.

Please be advised that the current Water Use Licence, PM04-381, will expire on October 31, 2009. As a new Water Use Licence will not be issued prior to this, the application will not be viewed as a renewal and will be processed as a stand alone application.

Yukon Environmental and Socio-economic Assessment Act

The Yukon Water Board has determined that all water use applications must include a completed YWB Project Confirmation Form and the YESAA Decision Document. Once the YESAA Decision Document has been completed, please review your application and determine if your project has been changed from what you have described in your water use application, as a result of the YESAA process.

It is your responsibility to inform the Water Board by completing the YWB Project Confirmation Form and providing details of any changes to your application. A Project Confirmation Form is enclosed.
