Hi Dave,

I spoke with Sean Collins at DFO and he provided the clarification I was seeking. Essentially, if you are moving the creek temporarily you need to fill out an Appendix F and include the fish habitat features for temporary diversions. You have done this.

The second Appendix F is for when you discontinue the temporary diversion channel and you put the creek back to its original location (final restoration channel). This Appendix F must reflect the fish habitat features for a Permanent Diversion channel.

1. Now I need you to clarify for me if the above scenario is consistent with Mr. Raugth's application. If so, then we have the 2 Appendix F's that are required. If not and the Permanent diversion channel is a different diversion, I will need you to clarify this.

2. The only revision I will need you to do, is to the Appendix F - Part 1. You have included Boulder Groupings as a fish habitat feature; however, it should reflect Rock Islands. The channel width you used in the calculation was 0.5 but it should have been 0.6m with a spacing of 12m ($20 \times 0.6 = 12m$). If you could revise this page and fax it to me, that would be appreciated.
