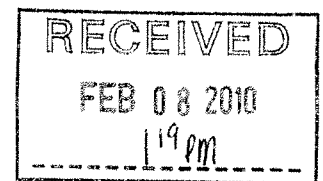

**Re: Request for Additional Information – Upper Dominion Creek  
Tributary of Indian R., Dawson Mining District, Quad 115 O/15d**

Thank you for your letter dated February 3, 2010 in reference to the above-noted placer mining application. The questions are answered in the same order they were listed.

1. Total water quantity is maximum 3 273 cu m per day, as shown on page 8. There was a discussion with my client that sufficient water for contingencies or for wet years be up to 3 600 cu m. The smaller amount is for an anticipated shorter day schedule and less material to be processed on the RL trib. to Upper Dominion. Mining is planned to move progressively and only one plant will be operating at one time. We trust this clarifies the situation, and if you have further questions, please do not hesitate to call. For now the Schedule 4 form will remain as is, and please accept the change to match on page 8 of the water board form.
2. The fuel tank registration form was mailed by Mr. Phillips to the address shown on the form, being the Whitehorse Mining Recorder's office. Janet Bell-MacDonald has been informed of this in Dawson, and the forms will be forwarded to you as soon as possible.

Contrary to the previous application, and this was related to Janet in Mining Lands-Dawson, Mr. Phillips has now purchased two 4,540-litre tanks from Martin Knutson. They have not been hauled to the site yet, and won't be till later in the spring. They will be placed inside a bermed and lined pit with a holding capacity of 110% of total storage quantity. Both tanks are welded steel, horizontal tanks in good condition.

3. Mr. Phillips will be contacting your office on Monday, February 8 to make the required application and land use permit payment of \$560.00. If someone could confirm this has occurred with me by e-mail, I can scratch that issue off the radar.

The YESAB process is now terminated and the Project Confirmation form was faxed to your office on Friday, February 5. However, a relatively important error was found in the Decision Document by Mineral Resources, and stemmed from errors in the Public Notice and the Recommendations by YESAB. Please note that as shown in the Water Board form on page 6 of 42, the correct amount of material to be processed per YEAR is 5,000-10,000 cubic metres, and NOT the stated 5,000-10,000 cubic metres per DAY. A notice had been sent out to some agencies involved with this application, but possibly not your office as this application had not yet been filed. The correction was missed by all subsequent parties.

The one intervenor in the YESAB public input stage has been notified of this error and may feel a lot better now. An effort has been made by Fast-Track to inform any relevant agencies so a proper correction may be made and the confusion eliminated. As such materials are available on the internet ad infinitum, we feel this is necessary.

Thank you for your time in reviewing this application in short delay. Please use e-mail for any further correspondence rather than regular mail to save time, paper and money. The project confirmation form does not need to be sent for every application, it is loaded on the computer here. In future they will be scanned and sent via e-mail, fax no longer being available.
