RE: Corrections to the Amendment numbers for Ross Mining Ltd., Water Use Licence PM93-064.

PM93-064 is a Renewal of Water Use Licences PM90-067, PM90-068 and PM90-083 – was signed March 15, 1994 and expires **March 15, 2013**.

PM94-050 – Serves as Amendment 1 of PM93-064. Signed on February 1, 1995. It is indicated on this licence that all rights and obligations conferred by PM93-064 are continued in full force and effect, so PM94-050 does not replace PM93-064. Expires March 15, 2013.

PM95-028 – Serves as Amendment 2 of PM93-064. Signed October 30, 1995. Please note that the licence amendment front page states it is amendment 2 of PM94-050.

PM97-047 – Serves as Amendment 3 of PM93-064. Signed May 7, 1998. Please note that the licence amendment front page states it is an amendment of PM94-050 and that all rights and obligations conferred by PM94-050 are continued in full force and effect. PM97-047 does not replace PM94-050, nor does it replace PM93-064. Expires March 15, 2013.

PM99-037 – Serves as Amendment 4 of PM93-064. Signed September 23, 1999. Please note that the licence amendment front page states it is amendment 1 of PM97-047.

PM01-231 - Serves as Amendment 5 of PM93-064. Signed November 28, 2001. Please note that this amendment states it is amendment 2 of PM97-047. PM01-231 was an omnibus amendment of several placer licence in order to remove Clause 41 with respect to stationary fuel storage.

According to the Technical wording of the *Waters Act*, none of the above mentioned amendments have replaced PM93-064. It still stands as the original active licence.
