

YUKON WATER BOARD
REASONS FOR DECISION
Water Use Application PM07-580, amendment to PM05-463
Ken Pratt

The Yukon Water Board (“the board”) has made licensing decisions with respect to water use application PM07-580, amendment number one to PM05-463 for a type B licence for a placer mining undertaking.

The purpose of the application is to add 5 additional grants to the current licence. No other changes to the mining plan were requested.

Notice of the application was provided in accordance with the requirements of the *Waters Act*. In response, the board did not receive any interventions.

This application required an environmental assessment under the *Yukon Environmental and Socio-economic Assessment Act* (“YESAA”).

Prior to making licensing decisions, the board reviewed the Decision Document that is included in the water use register. The board is satisfied that the licence and approval are not contrary to the Decision Document, as per section 86 of YESAA.

In making licensing decisions pertaining to this application, the board took into account the *Waters Act*, *Waters Regulation*, the application, the Decision Document, the board's standard licence requirements, Territorial Resources Base Map 115P/11, Chapter 14 of the Umbrella Final Agreement (“UFA”) and board policies.


Chapter 14 of the UFA

The board examined the proposed use of water as it relates to Chapter 14 of the UFA, as to quantity, quality, or rate of flow of water flowing on, through or adjacent to Settlement Land, including seasonal rate of flow, as follows:

The board reviewed Territorial Resources Base Map 115P/11, as referenced in the First Nation of Nacho Nyak Dun Final Agreement, and determined that, Vancouver Creek does not flow on, through or adjacent to Settlement Land, therefore the quantity, quality, or rate of flow of water flowing on, through, or adjacent to Settlement Land, including seasonal rate of flow will not be substantially altered.

Conclusion:

The Board has approved the issuance of Water Use Licence PM07-580.
