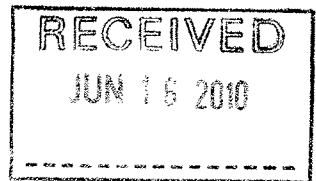

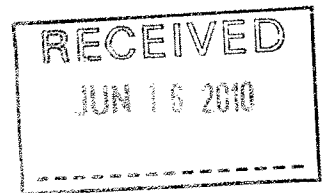
Alexco Resource Canada Corporation (ARCC) is aware that Alexco Keno Hill Mining Corp. (AKHM) has applied for a Type A water licence to authorize the use of water and the deposit of waste for the purpose of the construction and operation of the Bellekeno Mine and Mill Project that is the subject of water use licence application QZ09-092 (the "Type A Licence"). ARCC hereby agrees that within a 30 days following the issuance of the Type A Licence, ARCC will apply to the Yukon Water Board for an amendment of its advance exploration Type B Water Licence QZ07-078 (the "Advance Exploration Licence") to amend or cancel the Advance Exploration Licence to the extent it would conflict or be inconsistent with provisions of the Type A Licence. ARCC hereby authorizes AKHM to bring the contents of this letter to the attention of the Yukon Water Board for the purposes of the public hearing concerning water use licence application QZ09-092.

Pursuant to the joint venture agreement between them whereby Alexco Keno Hill Mining Corp. (AKHM) is to operate the Bellekeno Mine and Mill project on the quartz mineral claims held by Elsa Reclamation and Development Company Ltd. (ERDC), AKHM has applied for a Type A water licence to authorize the use of water and the deposit of waste for the purpose of the construction and operation of the Bellekeno Mine and Mill Project that is the subject of water use licence application QZ09-092 (the "Type A Licence").
