

Re: Intervention Correction for Type B Water Licence Application QZ01-051, Expatriate Resources Ltd., Advanced Underground Exploration Program, Wolverine Property.

This letter is to advise the Yukon Water Board and the Applicant, Expatriate Resources, to correct the recommended effluent level for arsenic in the table on page 2 of the Yukon Government intervention. Environment Canada changed the recommended effluent level of arsenic from the initial 0.05 mg/l to 0.10mg/l at the last minute prior to submitting their intervention. The Yukon Government's position remains the same as stated in 'Recommendation #1' of its intervention, that it supports effluent standards as recommended by Environment Canada. Therefore the table that follows this statement would be in error for arsenic, so please rely on the statement, not the numbers.
