 Bellekeno Advanced Underground Exploration & Development, Keno Hill Silver District**

This Erratum to Project No. 2008-0028 is to correct the following:

- Estimates of the volume of rock to be excavated previously totaled 278,500 tonnes of rock for the duration of the underground exploration and development program; however, upon reconsideration there is expected to be a total of approximately 248,500 tonnes of rock moved to the surface.

The attached summary table shows the revised estimate of waste rock anticipated to be brought to surface during years 2 to 5 of the program.

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

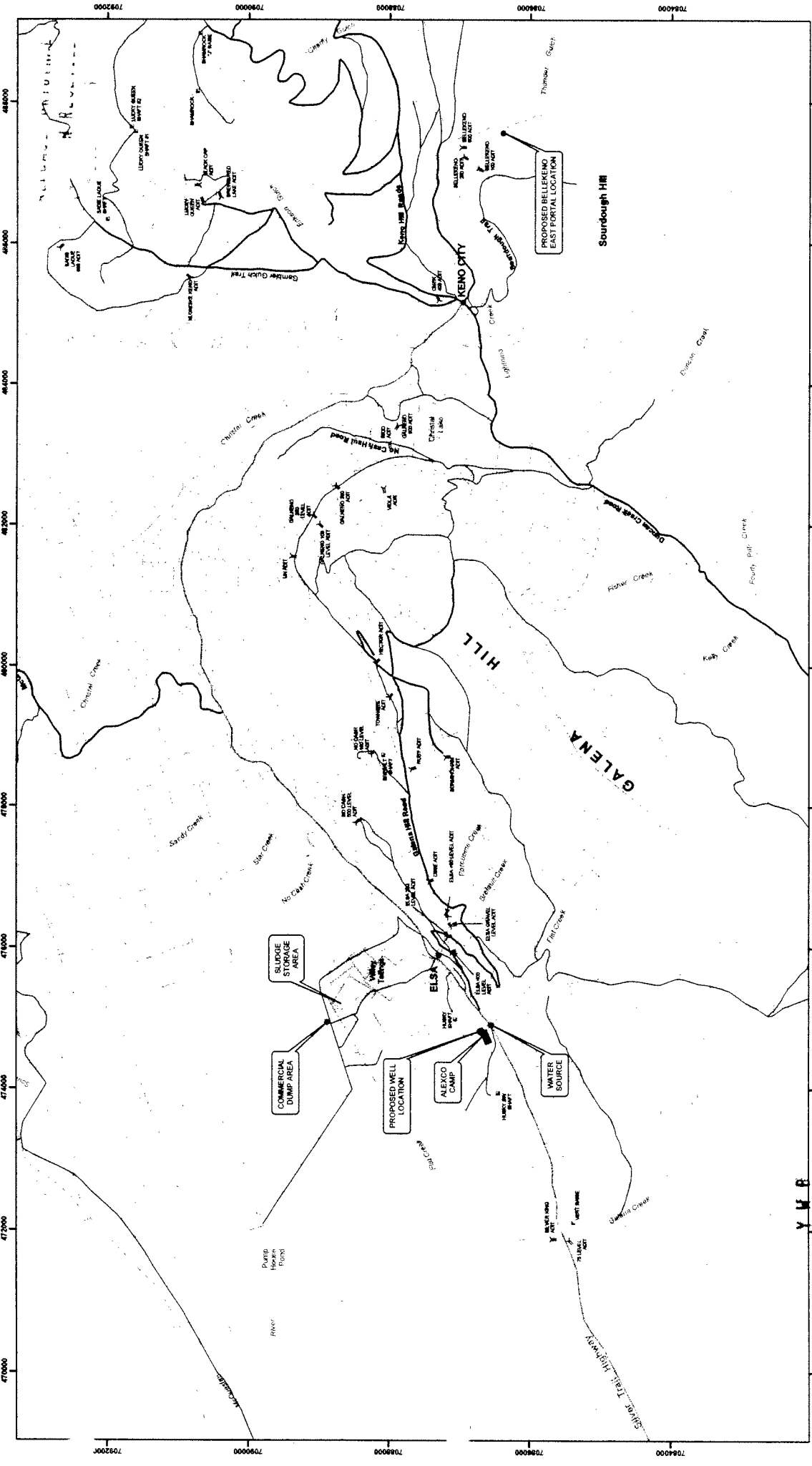
