AMENDMENT OF WATER USE LICENCE

LICENSEE: Annie Lake Golf and Country Club **LICENCE NUMBER:** Y-RE86-01L

AMENDMENT NUMBER: One (1) **APPLICATION NUMBER:** RE99-007

Pursuant to the *Yukon Waters Act* and Regulations, Water Use Licence Y-RE86-01L is hereby amended as follows:

1. Quantity of Water Not to be Exceeded:

- Delete "87 acre feet per year" and replace with "128,154 m³ metres per year"
- Delete "188,185 imperial gallons per day" and replace with "854 m³ per day"

2. The following sub-clause is added to Clause 7 (Annual Report):

- d) describe all pesticide use carried out during the year, including, for each product, the date, location, method of application and extent of use; the name of the product used, and the rate of application.

3. The following clauses are added to Part C (Conditions Applying to Operation):


- 3. The use of the following pesticides is permitted:
 - Daconil 2787 Flowable Fungicide
(Pest Control Products Act Registration #15724)
 - Wilson Tri-kill Turf Herbicide
(Pest Control Products Act Registration #19400)
 - Roundup Liquid Herbicide
(Pest Control Products Act Registration #13644)
 - Scotts Proturf Granular Fungicide V
(Pest Control Products Act Registration #11466)

- Scotts Proturf Granular Fungicide X
(Pest Control Products Act Registration #23494)
 - Scotts Proturf Granular Systemic Fungicide
(Pest Control Products Act Registration #16660).
4. Pesticides shall be handled and applied according to the manufacturers' recommendations as registered under the *Pest Control Products Act* (Canada) and as specified in the product labelling.
 5. Equipment and containers used for applying pesticides shall not be filled, rinsed or stored within 100 metres of any watercourse.
 6. Prior to disposal in a municipal landfill, empty pesticide containers shall be rinsed a minimum of three times and the rinse water shall be used for spraying purposes.
 7. Pesticides shall only be applied using a broadcast sprayer operating on the ground.
 8. Pesticides shall not be applied within 30 metres of any open water body.
